RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Bringing school diary is mandatory. If a student loses the diary, he/she will be subjected to disciplinary action. A fine of Rs. 100/- will be levied and a new diary will have to be purchased.
- 2. All the students must be neatly and smartly dressed in the school uniform.

- 3. Students' behaviour in the school bus should be polite and any indisciplined behaviour will make the student ineligible to use school transport.
- 4. Keep the school premises clean and tidy and use all school property with respect and care. Any damage done will be made good by damager.
- 5. All the students must come in school uniform on Parents' Teacher Meeting (PTM).
- 6. a) No books (other than text books, library books) magazine or papers to be brought to the school.
 - b) Students should not bring crackers, explosives and other dangerous material to school. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against such offenders.
 - c) Students are advised not to bring any valuable item or money to school. School will not be responsible for any loss.
- 7. Hillwoodians should behave in a courteous manner wherever they go. They should remember that the school is judged by their conduct.
- 8. Speaking in English is compulsory within the school premises. Marks will be deducted from Periodic Test and Examinations of the defaulters.
- 9. The student will be removed from school rolls for disobedience, dishonesty, misconduct, etc.
- 10. Any student found using unfair means in any examination will be debarred from that exam. Repetition of same will result in dismissal.
- 11. Students should take care to switch off lights and fans while leaving the room. Running and shouting inside the school building is unbecoming and forbidden.
- 12. Parents are requested to go through their ward's bag.
- 13. Polythene bags are not allowed in the school.
- 14. All students are expected to be present on the last working day before the vacations as well as on the first working day after the vacations.
- 15 It is mandatory for the parents to attend all the PTM's.

16. Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher/Headmistress/Principal is not allowed.

All these above acts of misconduct are the forbidden practices. In the above acts of misconduct, Principal/HOS shall take action as per observation of the disciplinary committee at school level depending upon gravity of misconduct, which may include:

- 1. Oral/Written warning to the students and parents.
- 2. Detention during the break for completion of neglected class work.
- 3. Suspension from attending classes/school for a specified period.
- 4. Recovery of loss through replacement to school property due to willful damage.
- 5. Expulsion/rustication from school for students of classes IX to XII in rarest of rare cases.

RULES CONCERNING ABSENCE

- 1. Except in the case of unforeseen illness, no leave may be taken without prior sanction from school authorities. Leave for more than three days must be accompanied with a medical certificate.
- 2. Attendance for WE, ASL, project/activities and Club activities is must and marks will be deducted for absence or non performance in these activities.
- 3. Student will not be sent early with parents on test day if child is found FIT to sit in class. No request will be entertained. Parents must follow the school rules for security reasons.
- 4. Repeated absence of child without leave or unexplained absence for more than 5 consecutive days renders the students liable to have his/ her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission will be totally at school's discretion with payment of Re-admission fee.
- Students suffering from chicken pox, measles, mumps, swine flu, tuberculosis or other communicable disease should produce a doctor's certificate stating that child is FIT after the infectious period of disease is over.
- 6. Attendance for WE, ASL, Projects activities and club activities is a must and marks will be deducted for absence or non performance in these activities.
- 7. Once morning attendance has been taken, students would not be allowed to go home. Except for emergency medical reasons.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. 75% attendance is mandatory for the students (Classes 1 XII)
- 2. Two marks will be awarded in Class/Periodic Test for 95% and above attendance.
- 3. One mark will be awarded in Class/Periodic Test for 85% and above attendance.
- 4. The reporting time for students is 7.40 am (Summers) and 8.00 am (Winters)
- 5. School gates will be closed five minutes after reporting time and late comers, for more than three times, will be sent home without information.
- 6. Parents should strictly avoid taking their children away from school during school hours for trivial reasons (especially on Class tests and Periodic test day).
- 7. Absence from school prior to a test is not allowed except for genuine reason.
- Mobile phones are not allowed. Strict disciplinary action will be taken and the mobile phone will be confiscated for 20 working days. Non-adherence to this rule may also lead to expulsion from the school.
- 9. Distribution of gifts/eatables is not allowed. Chewing of gum is not allowed on school campus or school bus.
- 10. Students are not permitted to use two/four wheeler motor vehicles.

SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The time a student spends in the school should enable him/her to acquire sound principles of conduct and action and lay a solid foundation of true and purposeful living when he/she attains adulthood. Principles of honesty, trust, cooperation, self reliance and hard work are inculcated through various school activities. In these activities the student learns to do things himself/herself under the guidance of coordinators. They are given the opportunity to see the practical application of the abstract ideas.

THE HOUSE SYSTEM

A number of activities are conducted under the guidance of the house coordinators/house mistresses, (Nalanda, Sanchi, Takshashila, Ujjain houses) assisted by captains and prefects appointed for various activities.

STUDENT'S COUNCIL

A council of students is selected by the Principal in consultation with the Headmistress, Coordinators and teachers. The students council looks after the discipline and co-curricular activities in the school under the supervision of the Principal and other concerned staff.

CLUB SYSTEM

School also has club system with experienced teachers as heads of respective clubs. Students are given an opportunity to choose a club of their choice based on their ability and interest. Some of the clubs are Environment club, Dramatics club, Mathematics club, Science club, UN Club, Press Club, Debating club, Community Service club, Quiz club, Music club, Dance club, Computer club, Wellness club, Astronomy club, Disaster Management club and many more.

SPORTS

Facilities are provided for the following: Athletics, Basketball, Cricket, Hockey, Football, Hand Ball, Volley Ball, Aerobics, Gymnastics, Yoga, Karate, Skating, Table Tennis etc.

Students are encouraged to take part in team games. The keen competition on the playground tends to develop sportsmanship. Achieving a high level of individual performance is commendable, fostering the spirit of team work is even more strongly insisted upon.

Let's Know Our Houses: Historical Background

TAKSHASHILA

It is a city and an important site in the Punjab province of Pakistan. It is situated about 32 km to the North West of Islamabad in Rawalpindi in Punjab. Takshashila was a centre of higher learning and education. Takshashila is considered a place of religious and historical sanctity by Jains and Buddhists. Chanakaya and Emperor Chandragupta studied at Takshashila. In 1980, it was declared as UNESCO World Heritage Site.

NALANDA

It is the name of an ancient centre of higher learning in Bihar. It was a Buddhist centre of learning. Some buildings were constructed by the Mauryan Emperor Ashoka, some by the Gupta Empire and Emperor Harsha. Some famous places near Nalanda are - Rajgir, Bodhgaya, Gaya and Pawapuri. Chinese pilgrims, Fahien and HuTsang stayed in Nalanda University to read Buddhist scriptures.

SANCHI

Sanchi is a small village in east of Bhopal in Madhya Pradesh. Sanchi is known for its stupas, monasteries, temples and pillars. It is related to Buddhism and King Ashoka. It has been a centre of Buddhist learning and architecture.

UJJAIN

It is an ancient city near the eastern bank of river Kshipra in Madhya Pradesh. It was the administrative centre of Ujjain District. It is one of the seven sacred cities of ancient times. Kumbh Mela is held there every twelve years. King Vikramaditya, famous Mathematician Brahmagupta and Bhaskara II stayed in Ujjain.



1. APPRECIATION CARD: ORANGE CARD

Improvement in Behaviour, Academic, Attendance and Life skills will be appreciated and may help to improve the overall personality of the learner.

2. WARNING: YELLOW CARD

It can be issued to the student in any of the following cases. If the student is -

- Indisciplined and has erratic behaviour.
- Does not abide by the norms.
- Discourteous and disrespectful.
- Uses abusive language.
- Talks rudely to the teacher.
- Spoils the decorum of the class
- Does not meet deadlines for submission of the work.
- Irregular and inattentive in class.
- Lacks concentration.
- Does not come in proper uniform.
- Irregularity, late coming and bunking the class or school.
- Brings mobile or other electronic devices to school.

Warning to the student for minimum three (3) times and then a point on yellow card will be issued which will be signed by the teacher, student and the parent. Three points on a yellow card would result in one point on red card.

3. SUSPENSION: RED CARD

It can be issued to the student in any of the *following major* offences.

- Bullying and any damage to the School property, (premises/bus)
- Damage to the neighbourhood property
- Reacting inappropriately to other children personally, alone or with other students.
- Cheating and lying repeatedly.

Any major offence would give the student a point on the red card and immediate suspension for 10 days with the consent of the Principal. Student can enter the class after the suspension period, only with the permission of the Principal after giving an apology letter duly signed by the parents.

4. ATTENDANCE: WHITE CARD

Regularity in attendance and punctuality will be appreciated and students with 100 % attendance will be awarded with a certificate.
