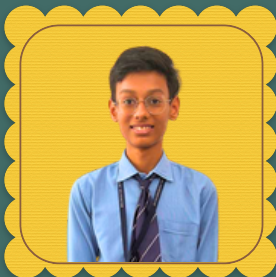


OUTSTANDING CBSE RESULTS

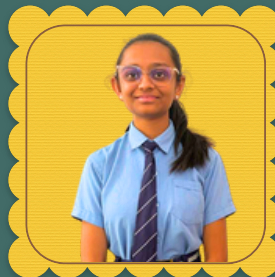

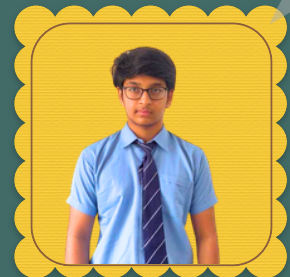

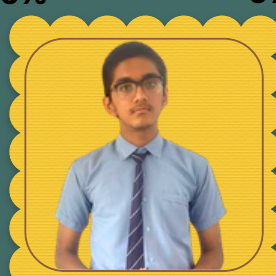

Thumb Dabbing Activity

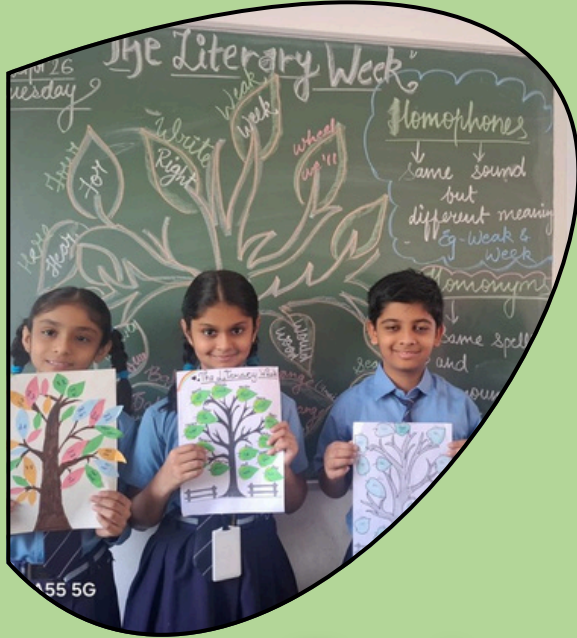
Nursery students created pineapple art using thumb dabbing, improving motor skills.

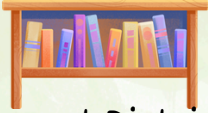


Camel Art Competition Excellence Awards

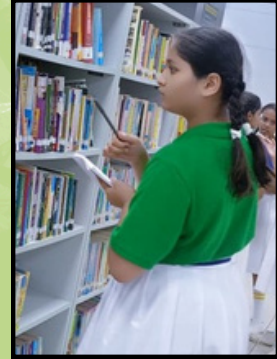

A Visit to the World of Books



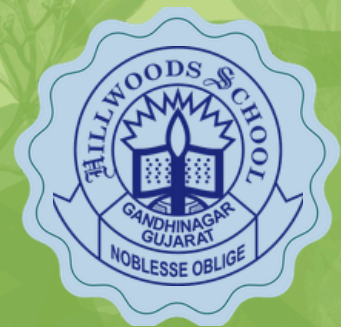
